Chicago Biomedical Consortium (CBC) invites faculty members at UIC, Northwestern, and UChicago to attend a **Workshop on the CBC Catalyst Award program**. The Catalyst program offers funding of up to **\$200K** for <u>new</u> inter-institutional collaborative research projects. Projects should focus on systems biology, as broadly defined, and aim to address an important biological/biomedical question.

This workshop aims to demystify the Catalyst program and help the CBC community members prepare strong proposals for the **next deadline (March 6, 2013)** and beyond. Principal investigators from UIC who received CBC Catalyst Awards will present case studies to illustrate successful collaborations and proposals, and a member of the CBC Scientific Review Board will provide a reviewer's perspective. CBC personnel will be available to answer questions.
